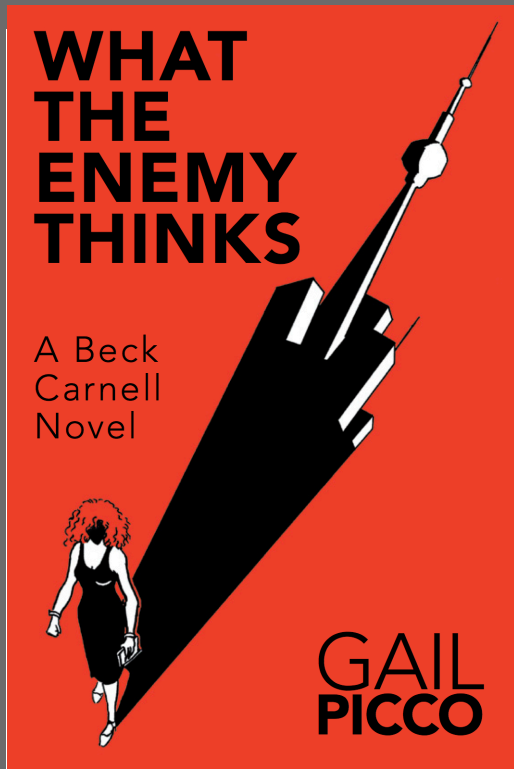


Reading Group Guide
